State Teachers Tests Guide For Teaching About Communism

Trenton, N. J. (NC) - From seven teachers in New Jersey high schools are testing a new guide designed to fill a need for teaching about communism.

The state Department of Education said the guide is also designed to contrast other totalitarian philosophies to American ideas of government. It is titled "Ideology and World Affairs."

The guide is one part of a program of the North-eastern States Youth Citizenship Project sponsored by the Commissioners of Education in nine northeastern states and conducted by the Lincoln Plene Center for Citizenship and Public Affairs at Tufts University.

It was prepared last summer at the first annual workshop on "Basic Issues in Citizenship" by 23 teachers chosen by the commissioners.

Governor Asks New Study of College Needs To Include Private Schools

Trenton (NC) - Gov. Richard J. Hughes said Monday to appoint an impartial board to study "all college resources, public and private," in New Jersey.

The Governor disclosed the plan Jan. 8 in his annual message to the Legislature. Its particular feature was the inclusion of private colleges because a recent state-sponsored study was limited to public institutions.

Gov. Hughes made only brief mention of the previous study, known as the Strayer Report and undertaken last year for the state Department of Education. That report urged the expenditure of \$27 million for five years on public higher education.

The Governor said that the study he proposed would "evaluate the effectiveness (of public and private colleges) in imparting quality education to an increasing number of students."

"More importantly, the estimates of the numbers of out-of-state youth who will be seeking higher education in the years ahead," he said, "we know that our present facilities, public and private, are inadequate to meet the demand. Catholicism Pertains To More Than Person, Family, Social Order Editor Says

Bostford, N.J. (NC) - "To get the idea that Catholicism pertains only to individual and family morality and has nothing to say about social morality is to lose the true vision of Catholicism," Father Louis J. Twomey SJ, editor of Social Order said here.

Speaking before a meeting of the Catholic Employers and Managers Association, the "Idea added...

"Christ's doctrine applies to the whole of life, whether on the individual or social level" he went on, "and Catholics, whether they be priests, nuns, or laymen, if they understand the social doctrines of the Church, they must labor to bring Christ into institutional framework of society."

The priest from St. Louis, long active with numerous social action groups, addressed some 30 members of the employers and managers group, who have handed together to apply the social teachings of the Church to modern business situations.

Officially, the SS Cyril and Methodius 1100th jubilee year will close with ceremonies in Rome in September. Cardinal Amleto Cicognani, Vatican Secretary of State, will be celebrant of a Pontifical Mass at the Basilica of St. Clement over the tomb of St. Clement on Sept. 11.

Cardinal Theodor Koho, O.S.B., is scheduled to have the sermon. On Sept. 12, Cardinal Carl Confalonieri, Secretary of the Consistorial Congregation, will offer up Mass at the Basilica of St. Mary Major. On Sept. 13 Stations of the Cross will be recited at the Colosseum. On Sept. 14 pilgrims will be received in audience by Pope John XXIII. On Sept. 15 Cardinal Eugene Tisserant will preside at the dedication and blessing of the SS. Cyril and Methodius Mission Institute in Rome.

"The Situation in Slovakia has taken a turn for the worse as the communist regime is tightening its controls. The Philadelphia Inquirer reported on Dec. 24 that a Slovak priest, Fr. Augustin, was sentenced to a 3-year term in prison on the charge that he was painting "dirty pictures."

A Canadian reporter, David Dancin, featured a story on Slovakia in the Windsor Star before Christmas. He returned from a trip to Europe recently and spent several days in Bratislava. He said the Slovaks are as different from the Czechs as the English are from the Italians but made the statement that "their language is the same" (the knower neither language obviously). However, he reported that the Prague politicians admit that Slovak nationalism always has played a major role.

A historic series of SS. Cyril and Methodius stamps commemorating the 1,100th anniversary of the coming of the brother Apostles to Slovakia was issued in Rome at the newly founded SS. Cyril and Methodius Institute. The first series is in red, green and purple.

SLOVAK NEWS AND VIEWS BY REV. A. V. PIER, O.S.B.

A quarter of a century ago, precisely on Jan. 15, the founder of the Slovak community of Benedictine monks at St. Andrew's Abbey died in his fifty fifth. The Very Rev. Gregory Vanisalik, O.S.B., was a dedicated man of God, full of zeal and good works. As a boy who dreamed of becoming a priest while watching sheep in the Saris hills of his native Slovakia, he did not realize that the dream would be fulfilled thousands of miles from his homeland. It was while he studied with the Benedictines at St. Procopius Abbey in Lisle, Illinois, that he had the vision of founding a Slovak Benedictine monastery at home. This, too, became a reality, for 5 years after his ordination to the priesthood (1914), Rev. Stanislaus Grunec, O.S.B., one of his proteges, was sent to Cleveland at the end of January, 1922, to lead the vanguard for the new foundation at St. Andrew's parish in East, Mass. and Superior Avenue, New York. A half century after Father Vanisalik's ordination, the home that he established under the patronage of the Order of St. Benedict had a personnel of 76 priests and brothers who are engaged in the work of religious service, education, parochial work and publication. In that time seven priests and a brother have followed their founder to their eternal home.
