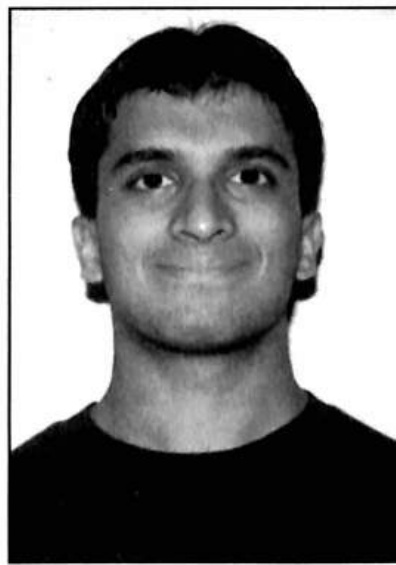

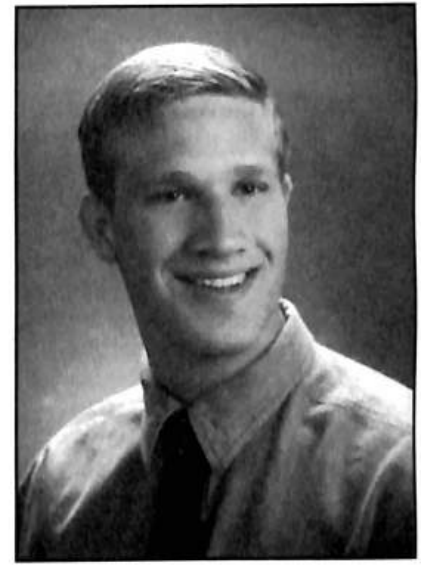

1997 American Sokol Slet "Catch the Spirit"

The 1997 American Sokol Slet held in the Chicago area, June 25-29, 1997 exceeded expectations in every aspect. The new events -- Fun Run/Walk, Swimming, 3-on-3 Basketball, and Tag-Team Gymnastics were all overwhelming successes. These events plus Golf and Bowling drew a number of participants to the Slet who might otherwise have only been spectators.

The Slet activities got off to an outstanding start with 299 walkers and runners participating in the inaugural Fun Run/Walk. Each participant proudly wore their "I Caught the Spirit" t-shirt. The first day ended with a stirring, heart pumping Opening Ceremonies featuring general Gymnastic Special Numbers presented by Sokols Ft. Worth, Tabor, Brookfield, Stickney, Naperville, Berwyn-Slavsky, KHB - Ennis, and the Central District Tumbling Team.

Three days of competitions in artistic and rhythmic gymnastics (ages 6 to 70+), golf, volleyball, bowling, swimming, team marching, team calisthenics, and 3-on-3 basketball followed. Winning competitors were recognized at the Awards Dance with personal medals and team trophies.

An activity filled competitor social at the Enchanted Castle and the formal Banquet provided enjoyable social evenings. A beautiful exhibit of Sokol memorabilia, artifacts, and treasures was available for viewing and reminiscing, and there were Slet souvenirs galore to match everyone's taste.

The Slet activities culminated with a breathtaking Sunday afternoon, 2000 participant Slet program of pageantry, folk dancing, apparatus performances, relay races, tug-o-war contests, and, of course, outstanding calisthenics performances.

It was obvious that everyone who was there had "Caught the Spirit" and was ready to pass it on to those unable to attend.
